



Students should refer to the Student Handbook for specific guidelines for information concerning the campus policies and individual responsibilities. The school recommends that students and employees promptly and accurately report crimes.

In accordance with Public Law 102-26, Student Right-To-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990, and amended as the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, all schools are required to provide annual information relating to crime statistics and security measures to students and employees. As part of the statistical report noted below, Baran Institute of Technology finds it essential to differentiate between the terms on-campus, public property and non-campus property. On-campus property is defined as the main campus and the acreage surrounding the actual physical plant and identified as part of the main campus. Public property is considered the immediate and close-by surrounding area of the school property and the actual physical location of the school. Non-campus property is considered the area in or near residential facilities that are used by students of the Baran Institute of Technology. In this case, from 2003-2005, it is primarily 1760 Mapleton Avenue, Suffield, Connecticut, and 2006-2007 it is either 1760 Mapleton Avenue, Suffield, Connecticut or 85 Sigourney Street, Hartford, Connecticut, where the majority of the Baran Institute of Technology students have found comfortable and adequate housing for the duration of their educational time with the school.

Baran Institute of Technology’s campus does not currently provide residence facilities directly to students. However, we may assist students in finding housing when requested. The school does not employ its own security personnel, and therefore relies on state and local law enforcement personnel for any serious security efforts. Accessibility to Baran Institute of Technology’s facilities is limited to the posted hours of operation, beyond which the doors are locked.

Students or employees of the Baran Institute of Technology should report any crimes that occur on campus to the Vice President of Operations, Director of Education, or the Directors of Training. Their offices are located at 97 Newberry Road, East Windsor, CT, or they can be reached by telephone at (860) 627-4300. A Daily Incidents Log is available to anyone requesting it from the Registrar’s Office. Statistics from this log, if any, and local police reports are used to compile this annual security report. Students or employees making a report of a crime may request confidentiality, but the school does not guarantee that confidentiality will always be possible. There may be occasions when the reporter will need to be identified to those people participating in an investigation.

Baran Institute of Technology is committed to providing a crime-free environment and has put in place policies and procedures to inform students and employees about how to affectively prevent crime.
